The 5K, Fun Run, and Carnival is right around the

corner. TCS has reached just over 80% of its \$65,000 fundraising goal. TCS would like to thank those that have supported this event and also all those that came out to support the food truck to raise money for the 5K/Fun Run last Saturday. There were 66 elementary students participating in some way and the event raised over \$2,600 that went directly towards our fundraising goal.

The Fun Run & Carnival event will **kick off at 10:00 am** with a **5K** in the neighborhood surrounding TCS, plus a shorter **Fun Run** (approx. 1 mile around the school) for our little runners*. Those interested in the timed walk/run around the



neighborhood should select the 5K when registering. The shorter route will not be timed. The run/walk will be followed up by a carnival on the school grounds from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm. The carnival will include games, vendors, food and more. The 5K will be professionally timed again this year by Blue Ridge Timing via chipped bibs with medals for the top 3 male and female finishers in each age group (Under 13, 13-18, 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50+) and a medal for the overall best male and female runner.
