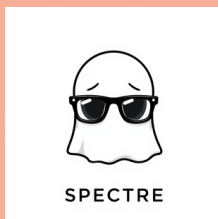

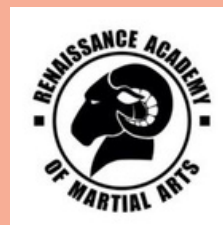

The Pre-K students are very excited about their chicken eggs that were placed in the incubator last week. The students are eagerly awaiting the arrival of the little chicks in about 21 days.



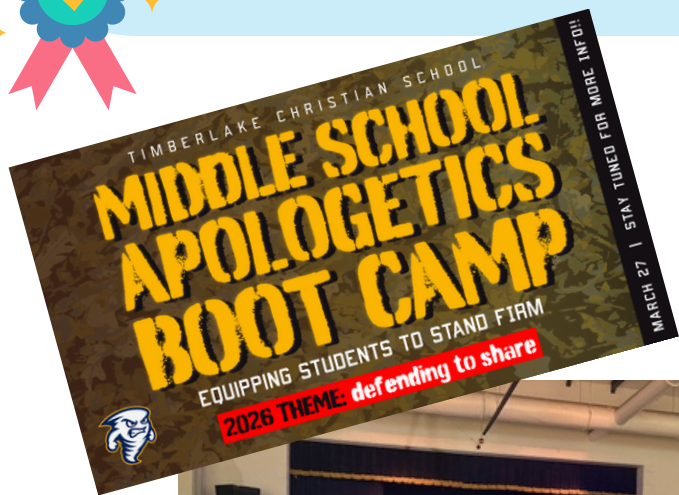
## International Math Competition Level 3

**Congratulations to James Thomas and Josie Kelley**, who have qualified to compete in Level 3 of the International Math Competition in April.

As mentioned prior, the International Math Competition exists to identify and elevate exceptional mathematical thinkers within our global ACSI community. Each student competes against other students in their grade and category. The areas of competition include arithmetic computation and mathematical reasoning. This year, nearly 7,000 students representing four countries participated in Level 1, showcasing the strength of mathematical excellence within ACSI schools globally.



Students in grades K-10 will have IOWA assessment testing during the mornings, the week of April 20 - 24. The Iowa test is a series of standardized achievement tests used to assess students in areas such as reading, language, and mathematics. These are important tests, and we encourage both parents and students to take them seriously. We encourage students to rest well the night before and eat a nutritious breakfast before testing each day.



Our middle school students had the opportunity on Friday, March 27, to spend some time considering the connection between apologetics and evangelism. Please join us in praying that the Lord would use this event to help the students stand firm in their faith.
