## HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS NIGHT

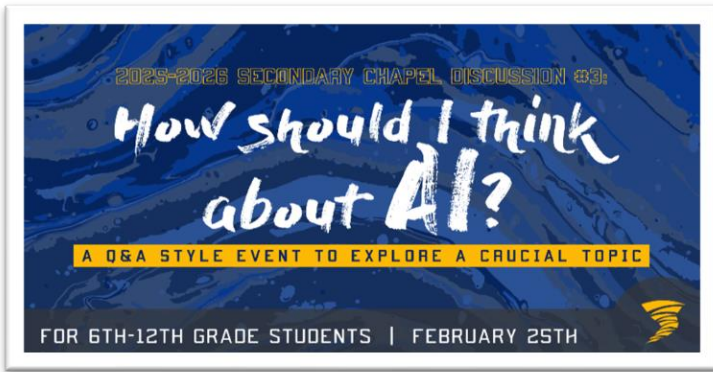

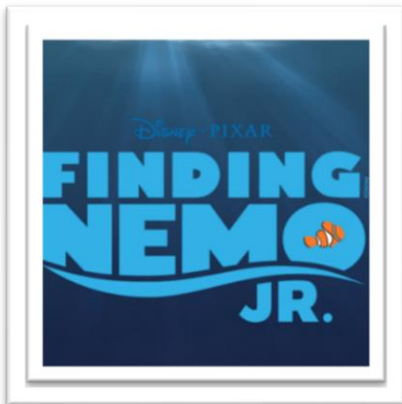
## SECONDARY CHAPEL DISCUSSION #3:

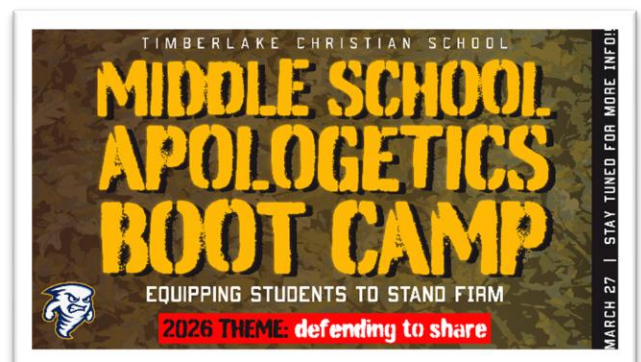


## SPRING MUSICAL

# TCS UPDATES

## SAFETY AWARENESS INITIATIVE

In an effort to keep safety at the forefront, TCS is launching a “**Say Something**” awareness initiative. Research shows that in over **90% of school shootings or acts of violence, warning signs were present beforehand.**

To help prevent concerns from escalating and to identify potentially threatening situations early, TCS has posted “**See Something, Hear Something, Know Something, Say Something**” signs throughout the school. These signs include a **QR code** that allows students to confidentially report any concern.

This system provides a **direct and secure line of communication** with our safety team, enabling them to assess the situation promptly and determine the most appropriate response. Safety is a shared responsibility, and by speaking up, we can care well for one another and help ensure TCS remains a safe and nurturing environment for all.



## K-12 STUDENT DROP OFF & PICK UP

Are you coming into the building to drop off or pick up your K-12 student? We request that you enter the building through the main office doors as opposed to the junior high or elementary entrances.

## VIRGINIA HOUSE BILL 359 – TAKE ACTION

There is currently a bill up for consideration in the House that would require private schools with even one student receiving tuition assistance, including the federal scholarship tax credit rewards many of our TCS families receive, to comply with the same mandates as public schools. This could include mandatory SOL testing, eligibility and compliance mandates, admissions and nondiscrimination requirements, and religious instruction restrictions. Mark your calendar! **Friday, February 20<sup>th</sup>** is Spirit Day for all TCS staff and students.

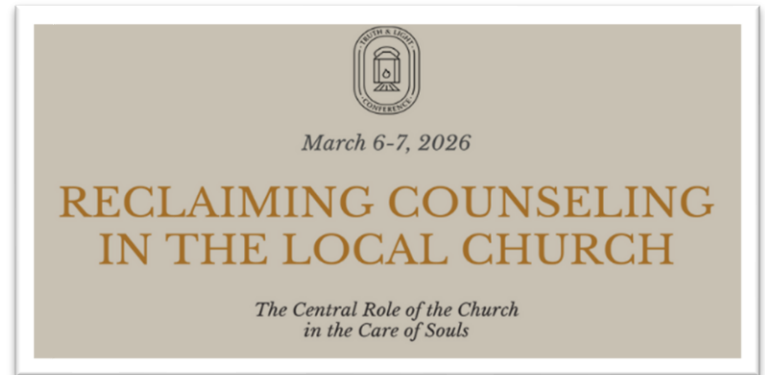
On Spirit Day, TCS students can show their school spirit by dressing down and wearing jeans along with a TCS spirit t-shirt. The spirit shirt must be visible.
