Adherence to the most recent COVID-19 guidance for the State of Virginia is requested. The carnival will include games, vendors, and food trucks. The 5K will be professionally timed via chipped bibs with medals for the top three finishers in each age group. Each walker/runner registered by March 25th, 2021 will receive an official TCS 5K, Fun Run and Carnival T-shirt!

Our fundraising goal for this year's event is \$30,000. Students are encouraged to work towards a goal of \$100 per student in sponsorships for their run/walk. Every penny earned during this event will go towards the general budget of the school and enable us to maintain daily operations.
