Words can barely express how thankful we are for such a wonderful 5K, Fun Run & Carnival event last month. The weather was perfect, and hundreds participated and cheered on those running and walking. We had three hundred forty-three registered runners/walkers. The first-place overall finish went to Mario Cosentino with a time of 20 minutes and 43 seconds.



We were thrilled to have raised 200% of our projected goal totaling \$60,293! Tuition alone does not cover the cost of educating a child. These funds will help TCS fulfill its mission and improve the quality of our service to our students. A portion of these funds will be used to revamp our elementary entrance, provide additional bathroom facilities, and improve our access to technology.
