## UPCOMING CHANGES

For safety & security, FACTS is transitioning to a **multi-factor authentication** method for logging in to all of its platforms. What does this mean for you?

1. **Starting May 6**, when accessing the FACTS application, you will be prompted to enter a **user ID, password, AND a numeric code which will be sent to you via email or through an authenticator app.**
2. You may be prompted to change your username and/or password on 5/6.
3. TCS will no longer be able to update or create passwords.
4. Students will continue to log in with only a username and a password.

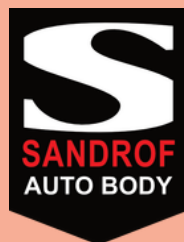
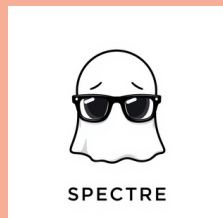

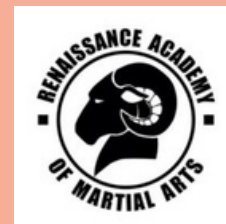
