The TCS / Play it Again Sports School Spirit Store will be open in November. All items ordered will be delivered to TCS and sent home with your student. Orders generally arrive three weeks after the store closes. The TCS Spirit Store will be **open** from **November 17th-23rd**. Note: Key facts you will want to know while you shop:

1. TCS Gear is broken down into **two categories: approved school clothing** (K-12, divided by youth/men/ladies) **and spirit wear** (divided by youth/men/ladies).
2. The approved school clothing includes **polos (both long and short sleeve), hoodies, and 1/4 zip pullover shirts**. **These items can be worn to school any day**. Students who opt for the **hoodies or 1/4 zip pullovers do NOT have to wear their TCS polo underneath, BUT** you will not be able to remove the hoodie/quarter zip without a polo to wear.
