DATES TO REMEMBER

OCTOBER 13 - No School: School is closed for K through 12th grade for Professional Development Day.

Note: TCS is facing a reaccreditation year for K-12 which is a substantial addition to the workload on faculty and staff. A complete 100-page self-evaluation report will be completed by late January and an accreditation team will be coming later in April. Fall Break is a scheduled Professional Development Day for K-12 faculty and staff to work on this report. Given the additional challenges TCS has faced this year, TCS will be moving up K-12 Fall Break one day, to start on Wednesday, October 13, instead of Thursday, October 14. This will allow the faculty and staff to work on accreditation both Wednesday and Thursday and still get a needed extended weekend break.

OCTOBER 14-15 - No School: School is closed for Half Day Pre-K through 12th grade for Fall Break.

October 13 Extended Care:

Extended Care for K-8 grade children who need childcare, will be offered on Wednesday, October 13 for those who sign up by Wednesday, October 6. For this day <u>only</u>, there will be no charge for children who need care <u>and are signed up ahead of time</u>. October 14-15 Extended Care:

STATEMENT OF FAITH
