CHAPELS

TEACHER ON CALL

We will once again offer the Teacher On Call program for students in K-12th grade. All teachers will be in their classrooms on Wednesday and Thursday mornings from **7:45-8:10am**. These times are set aside for students needing extra teacher help with school work. Students should not enter classrooms before 7:45 or before teacher arrives.

FACTS ACCOUNTS

FACTS is a great place to stay up to date with student progress and is an excellent place to obtain work either before or after an absence from school. Students in grades 7-12 may request their own personal FACTS account from Mrs. Mears in the Student Services office. Note:

FACTS is currently having an issue with the *PayNow* feature and are working to fix it. Temporarily, families need to use the browsers Firefox or Microsoft Edge to make payments.

ATHLETICS



FALL SPORTS

With all the upheaval of COVID-19, there has been significant adjustments to the school's athletics program. The current plan is to be begin Fall Sport practices on **September 23**rd with a start of competition on **October 19**th. The season would conclude with VACA State Tournament (over the December 12th weekend). As it stands right now, only VACA competition is allowed.

If four or more schools experience closures before September 23rd, then Plan B is automatically instated.

Plan B looks similar to VHSL model. Winter sports would begin practices on November 1st with a start of competition on November 30th and conclude on February 13th. Fall sports would begin competition on February 15th and conclude on April 10th. Spring sports would begin on April 12th and conclude May 21st. Keep in mind, that all dates are subject to change.

TCS TEAM APP

The TCS Team App is the school's go to location for all things pertaining to athletics, the game calendar, practice schedules, and notifications. Both parents and players can login from a smartphone, tablet, or PC. The steps to download the Team App are as follows:

- In Google Play or App Store, search for Team App.
- 2. Tap go back to Log in or Sign Up
- 3. Enter your email address and then click continue.
- 4. You will need to retrieve the security code from your email.
- 5. Complete your profile by entering your full name, year of birth, and Country. Click Save.
- 6. Accept all the terms and conditions.
- 7. Be sure to allow Team App to send you notifications. Turn on notifications in your settings for Team App.
- 8. On the "Welcome to Team App!" page, select Search for an existing app.
- 9. Type **Tornadoes Athletics** into the search bar. Find the app with the TCS Tornado logo.
- 10. Tap on the banner that says "Become a member of this team app"
- 11. Select a team (e.g. JV Girls Volleyball). Switch the "I agree to provide my membership details to Tornado Athletics to on. Enter your mobile phone number as well.
- 12. Please complete the membership profile with a selfie photo and other relevant details. Be sure to click Save.
- 13. Select any other team sports you need.
- 14. Recommend subscribing to the schedule of your team so that all scheduled events get added to your iCalendar or personal google calendar. If changes are made you will see them in real time.
