SEPTEMBER 23rd – No School: School is closed for Pre-K through 12th grade for Parent Teacher Conferences.

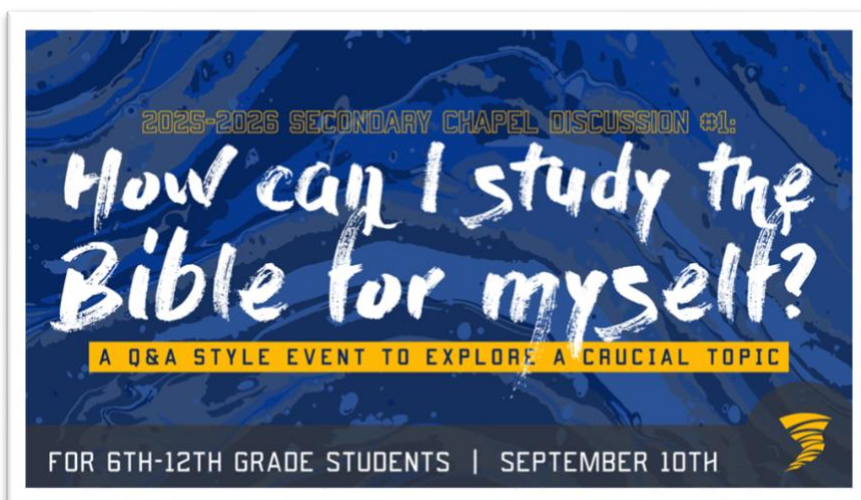
OCTOBER 9-10th – No School: School is closed for Half Day Pre-K through 12th grade for Fall Break.

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

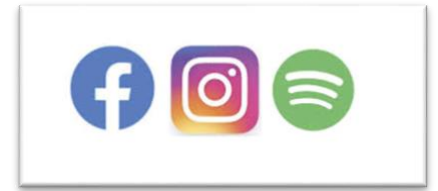

TEACHER ON CALL

ATTENDANCE REMINDER

Please note: According to the Student Handbook, absences or tardies with valid reasons will be excused **only if parents notify Student Services within 48 hours** of the absence or tardy.

A separate communication is required for **each day** a student is absent or tardy, unless the student is on vacation. In that case, parents should provide the full date range in advance.

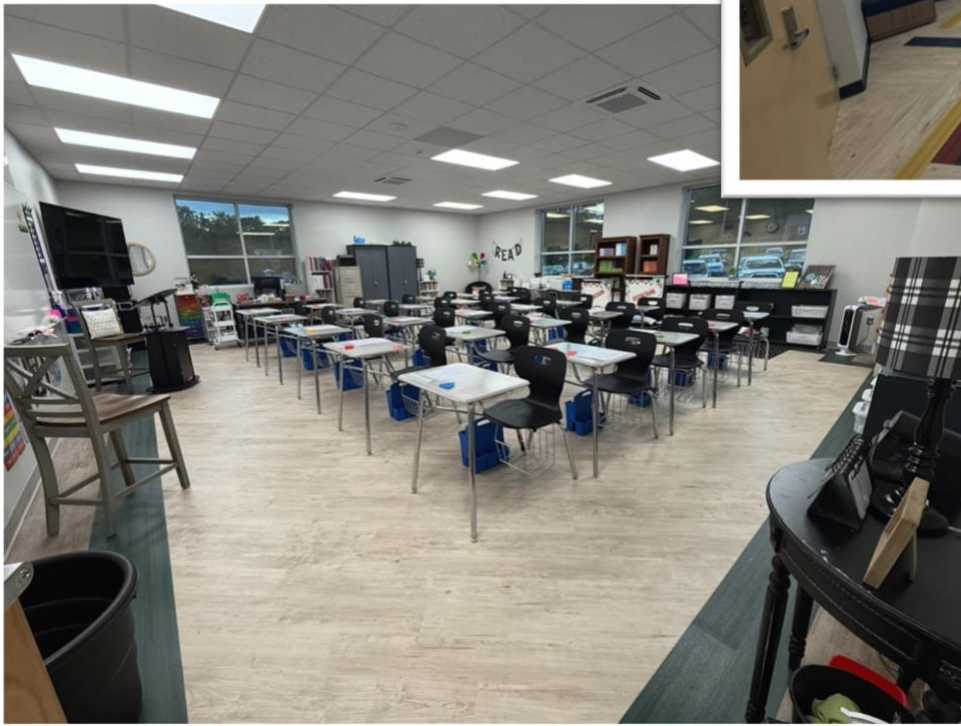
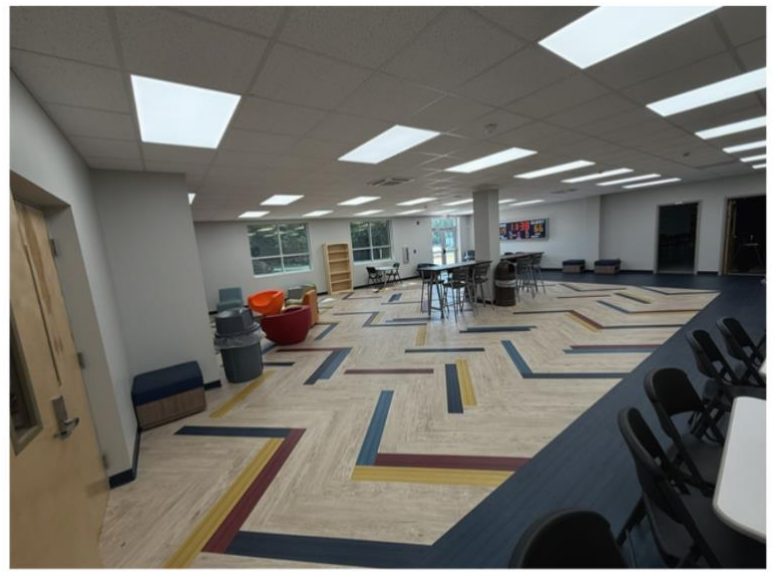
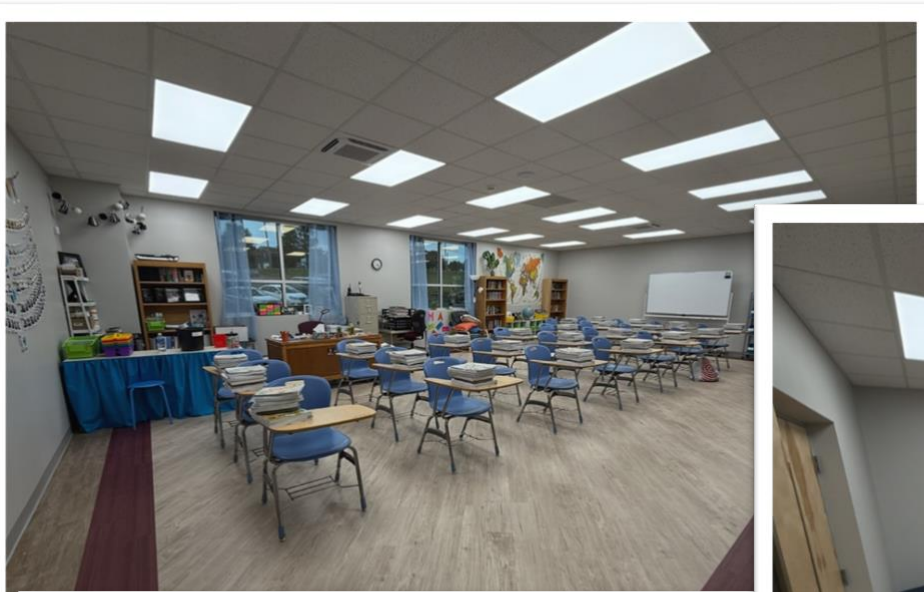
If a student is absent or tardy due to a medical appointment, a **doctor's note should be provided to the front desk** for the time to be excused.
